# Emergency Management Plan - Buysse - 0735000

Water Supply Equipment - Wells and Tanks

## **Electrical Outage**

Assess the Problem. Call either Mid American Energy or our electrical contractor to restore power. If water pressure falls below 20 PSI, issue a "Boil Order" to all water users.

#### Fire

Call the Fire Department and Mid American Energy. Assess the damage. Repair or replace damaged equipment. Issue a "Boil Order" if water pressure falls below 20 PSI.

## Lightning

Assess the Problem. Call either Mid American Energy or our electrical contractor to restore power, If needed. If Water pressure falls below 20 PSI, issue a "Boil Order" to all water users. Repair or Replace all damaged equipment.

#### Tornado

Assess the Problem. Call either Mid American Energy or our electrical contractor to restore power, If needed.

If Water pressure falls below 20 PSI, issue a "Boil Order" to all water users.

Repair or Replace all damaged equipment.

#### Flood

Assess the Problem. Call either Mid American Energy or our electrical contractor to restore power, If needed. Collect Water samples to determine if the water has been contaminated, Issue a "Boil Order" if needed. If Water pressure falls below 20 PSI, issue a "Boil Order" to all water users.

### Sabotage

Immediately Call the Sheriffs Department and preserve the crime scene as much as possible. Issue a "Do Not Drink Order" until it is determined there was no contaminates introduced to the well. If water samples show contamination, follow the instructions of the IEPA to correct the problem.

### Vandalism

Issue a "Do Not Drink Order" until it is determined there was no contaminates introduced to the well. Assume it's an act of sabotage and follow the same proceedures as above.

#### Drought

Increase Well Level monitoring.

Notify consumers to conserve water and Issue a watering ban.

#### EarthQuake

Assess the damage.

If Water pressure falls below 20 PSI, issue a "Boil Order" to all water users.

Repair or Replace all damaged equipment.

## Equipment Failure

Assess the situation and determine if a repair is feasable, or if a replacement is necessary. For a major piece of equipment, a permit may be needed before replacement can occur. Call the IEPA regional office for guidance if at all unsure.
